In November 2014 Pro-Bowl Safety Eric Berry was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Disease

Disease is a Cancer to the immune system

9,000 people diagnosed per year

Survival rate over 80%



Stuart Scott

In 2007 ESPN anchor Stuart Scott was diagnosed with cancer in the appendix

So rare American Cancer Society doesn't have a death rate

85% of patients have a 5 year survival rate

Stuart lost his battle to cancer on January 4, 2015
