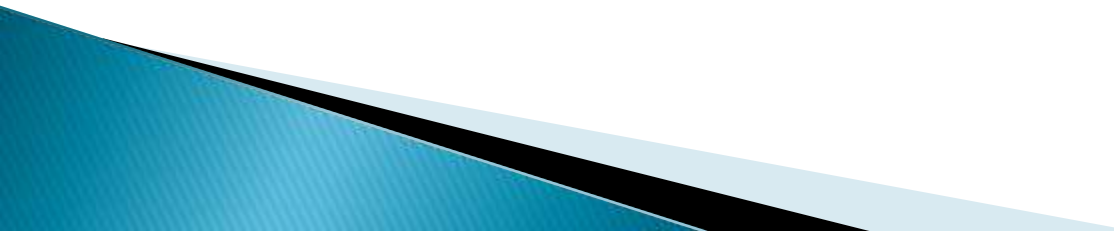


Issues With Title IX

What's the issue?

- ▶ More than 2,200 men's athletic teams have been eliminated since 1981 to comply with the proportionality prong of the 1979 Title IX Policy Interpretation.
 - ▶ Thousands of male athletes have been prohibited from participating in collegiate sports while men's athletic scholarships and coaching positions have evaporated.

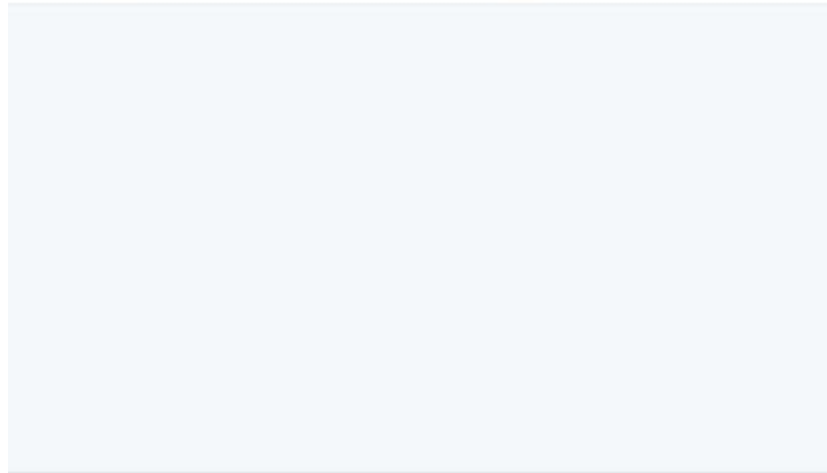
